The process of construction was terminated before reaching completion. A second temple was built by some Afghans from Kanchi. In the process of construction they did not follow the same pattern as the previous temple as they built the temple inside the fort walls. The shrine became too small and was excavated to make it bigger.

That temple is said to have been built by a woman Kanchipura Shakatá. It is said that the fortification of Kanchi was completed in two phases. The first phase was a fortification and the second phase were temples. Kanchi was maintained well and was never deserted like other towns and was well inhabited up to the 14th century.
